Configuring Zopier on a Computer

Zoiper is an open-source portable SIP softphone. It allows you to do high-quality VoIP calls via open SIP protocol.

- 1. Download **Zoiper** to your computer and open the app after installing it.
- 2. Insert **username** and **password**, and then click on login. Your username will be your number, including the country code, without the + at the beginning and spaces.

Example: 15084568090


The password is your number's password as set by you.



3. You'll need to insert the hostname provider which

is call.sipcity.com.au then click next.

- 4. In "Authentication and Outbound proxy" you can click on skip.
- 5. When the possible configurations come up, please choose whichever type of transport it is found and then click **Next**.



After this, the registration process is complete, and you should be able to see your phone registered now.
