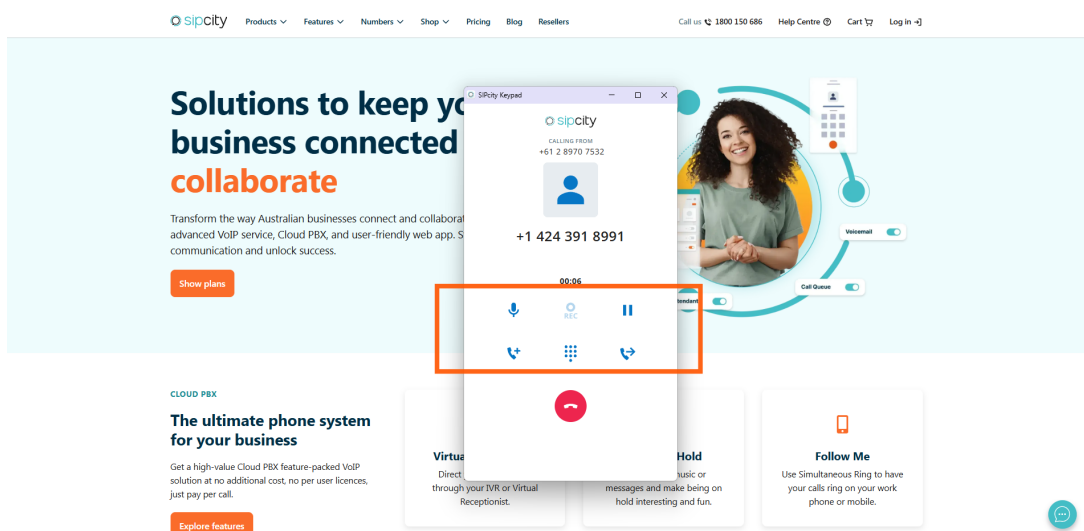

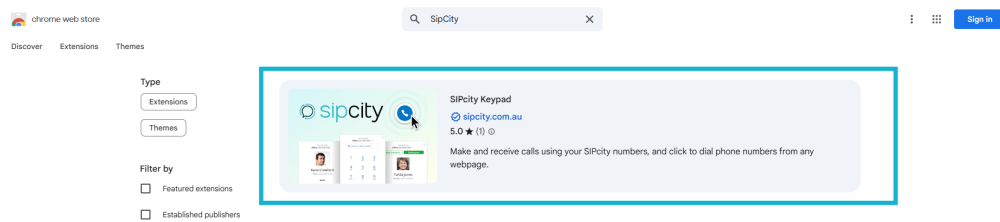

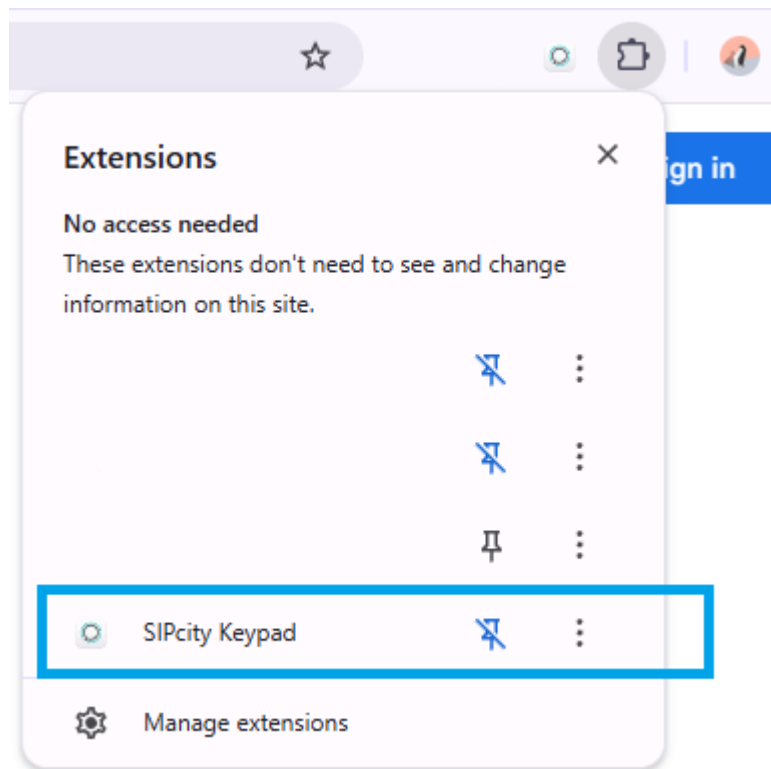


## How to Install your SipCity Keypad Extension
